Sub : Constitution of Eco Conservation Zone

Sir,

As per Resolution taken under Aganda No. 2 (ii) 21 Revenue Mouzas on the fringe of Gorumara National Park and 5 Revenue mouzas on the fringe of Chapramari Wildlife Sanctuary are to be declared as Eco Conservation Zone by Land & Land Reforms Department. In addition the following areas are also to be designated as Eco Conservation Zone –

- 1) Northern part of Apalchand Forest comprising Damdim, Paschim Damdim, Nipuchapur ets.
- 2) Gosairhat Beat in Moraghat Range
- 3) Sylee in Kalimpong Subdivision
- 4) Bandapani under Alipurduar district
- 5) Kunjanagar adjacent to Jaldapara National Park under Alipurduar District

Joint Survey in this regard needs to be taken up by the L&LR Department, District Administration and the Forest Department to finalise the mouzas involved in these areas, as mentioned above, for notification of Eco Conservation Zone.

I would request you to direct the concerned local Divisional Forest Officers of these areas to get the joint survey done and submit a compliance report to this Department.
